Haven for hiking

You'll be spoilt for choice with walking routes from this site, including many famous Peak District hikes such as Holme Moss, and also a long stretch of the Pennine Way. The area is also blessed with other historic attractions that don't require quite as much leg power, such as Ladybower Reservoir, the village of Castleton in the Hope Valley, and Chatsworth House and grounds a little further afield in the south.
